About the Symposium

Submissions: Abstracts and Papers

The abstracts and the full length papers will be reviewed before acceptance. The final acceptance will be based on the full-length paper which, if accepted for publication, must be presented at the symposium either as a oral presentation or a poster presentation. The language of the symposium will be English. Submission link is www.isgti2018.org. Few selected papers, after peer review, will be published in reputed Journals in the field of transportation geotechnical engineering.

The abstract should be submitted on A4 size paper and uploaded at www.isgti2018.org . The abstract should also indicate the technical theme under which it is intended to be published at the top right corner of the page. The length of the abstract should be limited to 300 words. The page should be formatted as given below:
